ABOUT THE CLINICAL ONCOLOGY COURSE.....

Although there has been rapid advances in the field of Oncology in the last few decades with state of the art technology creating modern machines and targeted drugs, the basic foundations of treatment remain multidisciplinary care. For residents entering the field of Oncology, a good grasp of the comprehensive stage wise management of common Cancers of different sub sites with emphasis on basic concepts of Radiation and Clinical Oncology is vital. Our aim is to provide this knowledge through a structured course aimed at JR1s and JR2s mainly which should act as a stepping stone for further in depth evidence based learning.

Every module has been created after critical self appraisal and peer review with the concepts in mind. Continuous and end of course evaluation will ensure bidirectional learning.
